

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
THOMAS COUNTY RECYCLING CENTER**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, Thomas County, Kansas, hereinafter referred to as "County," and the Governing Body of the City of Colby, Kansas, hereinafter referred to as "City," are interested in providing a Recycling Center for their communities to minimize landfill waste, and protect and preserve the environment; and

WHEREAS, County owns and operates a recycling center located in the City of Colby; and


WHEREAS, City desires to provide an opportunity for the use of the recycling center for its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, County and City agree:


1. County will provide, operate, and staff at its expense, and make available for use by the citizens of City during the hours of 7:00 am – 9:00 pm, summer hours, 7:00 am. – 7:00 pm. winter hours, 7 days a week, County's Recycling Center located at 815 E. College Dr., Colby, KS.
2. In consideration for the opportunity for the citizens of Colby to use the Center, City will pay the County the sum of \$6.50 per year, per citizen of the City based on the most recent United States Census.
3. City will provide to County, at no charge, utility services for the Recycling Center, which shall include, electricity, water, sewer, and garbage disposal.
4. City's payment for use of the Recycling Center shall be paid after receipt of County's invoice in January of each year, for that year. Payment for 2019 shall be paid in January 2019 after the invoice from County is received.
5. This Agreement shall be effective commencing January 1, 2019.

This Agreement will be effective upon approval by both County and City. It may be modified by mutual consent of the parties. Either party may terminate this Agreement by providing written notice to the other at least 90 days in advance of December 31, 2019, or December 31 of each renewal year. This Agreement shall renew automatically unless terminated as aforesaid.
