CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Chairman Mike Baughn called the SPECIAL Commissioners Meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. at the Thomas County Historical Courthouse on Thursday, August 18, 2022; followed by the flag salute (Pledge of Allegiance) with Commissioner Brian Luedke, Former Commissioner Paul Steele, County Clerk Keesa Mariman, Maintenance Director Josh Faber and Colby Free Press reporter Sloane Enninga.


COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS/CANVASS 2022 PRIMARY RECOUNT RESULTS: Chairman Mike Baughn moved to convene as the Board of County Canvassers with Paul Steele (former Commissioner) sitting in place of Commissioner Brad Flipse; the motion was seconded by Commissioner Brian Luedke, with no further discussion the motion carried unanimously. Paul Steele moved to accept the Recount Results of the Constitutional Amendment of 1723 YES votes and 820 NO votes; the motion was seconded by Commissioner Brian Luedke, with no further discussion the motion carried unanimously. Paul Steele made a motion to adjourn as the Canvass Board; the motion was seconded by Commissioner Brian Luedke, with no further discussion the motion carried unanimously.


