
PROHIBITING THE USE OF WRITE-IN STICKERS

WHEREAS Thomas County use an optical scanning system for election purposes and this system is used and maintained pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4601 et seq.; and since acquiring the optical scanning system the Thomas County Election Officer has determined that the proper functioning of the electronic vote counting machine and efficient conduct of elections require that valid write-in votes must be handwritten on the ballot and cast in the appropriate place; the use of stickers placed on the ballots by voters for such purposes should be prohibited

THEREFORE, effective the date of this Resolution shall be the official policy and practice of the Thomas County Election Officer; that a valid write-in vote for ballots counted by the optical scanning system shall be handwritten on the ballot and cast in its appropriate place on the ballot. No stickers are to be placed on the ballot, and any attempted vote for a write-in candidate by placing a sticker on the ballot will be counted through the board of canvassers.
