


RESOLUTION NO. 908


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS:

**2005 COMMUNICATIONS AGREEMENT**

**THIS AGREEMENT**, made and entered into this 16<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2004, by and between:

**The City of Colby, Kansas**, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "**CITY**" and **The Board of County Commissioners**, hereinafter referred to as "**COMMISSIONERS**."

**WHEREAS**, the **COMMISSIONERS** of Thomas County, Kansas, wish to enter into a contract with the **CITY** of Colby, Kansas, for the furnishing of communications for the County-Wide E-911 System, Thomas County Ambulance Service, Sheriff's Department, County Road Department and the citizens within all of the County of Thomas and upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set out:

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:**

1. This Agreement shall be for the period from January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005.
2. The **CITY** shall furnish 24-hour communications service for the County-Wide E-911 System, Thomas County Ambulance Service, Sheriff's Department, County Road Department and handling emergency and non-emergency calls for these services as needed.
3. For and in consideration of the **CITY** furnishing said services, the **COMMISSIONERS** agree to pay the **CITY** the sum of **Sixty-three Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-four Dollars and Fifty-eight Cents (\$63,234.58)** during the contract period.




