

**RESOLUTION NO. 911**

**A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF COLBY, KANSAS, TO EXECUTE A CERTAIN CONTRACT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THOMAS COUNTY, KANSAS, AND THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, CONCERNING PROVIDING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RESPONSE SERVICES AND RESCUE SERVICES TO AND FOR THOMAS COUNTY BY THE CITY OF COLBY.**


**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Colby, Kansas, a Municipal Corporation, are directed to execute on behalf of said City, a contract to provide hazardous materials response services and rescue services to the citizens of Thomas County, Kansas, for the period from January 1, 2005, through December 31, 2007, said contract attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully set out.

**AGREEMENT**

**THIS AGREEMENT**, made and entered into this 21<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2004,

**By and Between:**

The City of Colby, Kansas, a municipal corporation,  
hereinafter referred to as

**"City"**

**AND**

The Board of County Commissioners of Thomas  
County, hereinafter referred to as

**"County"**

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the County is required by K.S.A. 48-929 to establish and maintain a disaster agency responsible for emergency management and coordination of response to disasters, and;

**WHEREAS**, the City maintains a regular and volunteer fire department for the protection of lives and property from the hazards of fire and hazardous materials and rescue services within its city limits, and;

**WHEREAS**, the County is desirous for the City to provide hazardous materials response services and rescue services to and for Thomas County and will pay for said services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:**


1. This agreement shall be for the period from January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2007.
2. The City shall provide hazardous materials response services and rescue services to and for Thomas County.
3. For and in consideration of the City providing said services, the County agrees to pay to the City the sum of Fourteen Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$14,800.00) per year during the contract period.






