

RESOLUTION NO. 962

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS, TO EXECUTE A CERTAIN CONTRACT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THOMAS COUNTY, KANSAS, AND THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, CONCERNING PROVIDING COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE BY THE CITY OF COLBY TO THE CITIZENS OF THOMAS COUNTY, KANSAS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Colby, Kansas, a Municipal Corporation, are directed to execute on behalf of said City, the 2009 contract concerning providing communications for the ambulance service, Sheriff's Department and the citizens of Thomas County, Kansas, said contract attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully set out.

2009 COMMUNICATIONS AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 3rd day of June, 2008, by and between:

The City of Colby, Kansas, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "CITY" and The Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as "COMMISSIONERS."


WHEREAS, the COMMISSIONERS of Thomas County, Kansas, wish to enter into a contract with the CITY of Colby, Kansas, for the furnishing of communications for the County-Wide E-911 System, Thomas County Ambulance Service, Sheriff's Department, County Road Department and the citizens within all of the County of Thomas and upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set out:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:


1. This Agreement shall be for the period from January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009.
2. The CITY shall furnish 24-hour communications service for the County-Wide E-911 System, Thomas County Ambulance Service, Sheriff's Department, County Road Department and handling emergency and non-emergency calls for these services as needed.
3. For and in consideration of the CITY furnishing said services, the COMMISSIONERS agree to pay the CITY the sum of Ninety Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Fifty-two Cents (\$90,500.52) during the contract period.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have hereunto affixed their signatures this 3rd day of June, 2008.



Salaries

Dispatchers - Police Department - 2007 \$ 175,082.20

Social Security

0.0765 X \$175,082.20 = \$ 13,393.79

Medical Insurance

City pays 70% of premium
0.7000 X \$17,638.68 = \$ 12,347.08

Retirement

City pays 0.0431 of employee salaries
0.0431 X \$175,082.20 = 7,546.04
 City pays 0.01 of KPERS life insurance
0.0100 X \$175,082.20 = 1,750.82 \$ 9,296.86
