


Resolution # 2015-8

Thomas County has developed and promulgated a county wide Outdoor Warning Siren Activation Policy with the intention of saving lives and protecting property in the event of a major emergency or disaster by ensuring that all entities permitted to activate are operating by the same procedures.

This policy will assist in continuity for future officials and personnel to determine when is appropriate and when is not to sound the sirens. The Thomas County Outdoor Warning Siren Activation Policy has been developed to establish the guidance and procedures that will provide the elected and appointed officials, administrative personnel, and various governmental departments with the information required to function in a coordinated and integrated fashion and to ensure a timely and organized management of the use of the outdoor warning sirens.

As Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, I endorse this Policy, as approved by the Thomas County Board of County Commissioners on August 31, 2015 and direct that all personnel involved adhere to this policy and take appropriate actions as outlined herein.
