

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE NEIGHBORHOOD
REVITALIZATION PLAN OF THOMAS COUNTY, KANSAS**

WHEREAS, Thomas County, Kansas originally adopted a Neighborhood Revitalization Plan on May 31, 2012, to assist in the rehabilitation, conservation, or redevelopment of the specified areas within Thomas County which meet the conditions provided in said law; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Thomas County, Kansas pursuant to due notice did hold a public hearing on January 31, 2022, at 10:00 am to hear and consider public comment on amending the Neighborhood Revitalization Plan and held such hearing after publication at least once each week for two consecutive weeks in the Colby Free Press, Colby, Kansas, all as required by K.S.A. 12-17, 114, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, after such hearing, the Board of County Commissioners of Thomas County, Kansas met and considered amending of the Plan and the comments previously made thereon by the public.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Thomas County, Kansas that the Neighborhood Revitalization Plan of Thomas County, KS as attached hereto and made a part hereof is hereby adopted to take effect commencing January 31, 2022, for a ten-year period ending on January 31, 2032.

This resolution shall be effective upon its passage and after its publication in the Colby Free Press.




